2011 Spring Rally – ATV Travel in the Woods at Wallace, Idaho
June 15 to June 20

Ken & Arlene Casperson have promised us an exceptional rally. They are going to lead us into the wilderness of the Idaho Panhandle. We will be based in Wallace, Idaho. From our campground we will strike out to explore the most beautiful mountain range in Idaho.

An off-road ATV or Jeep is required for this rally. Breakfast can be had at the local cafe or home if you wish. The local cafe is just down the street and you can ride your ATV. From there we will depart for the trail of the day. Ken & Arlene have camped here for many years and are intimately acquainted with the area and the many trails.

We will explore for five days, commencing on Wednesday, June 15 and ending on Monday, June 20. There will be trails to explore, some high mountain lakes to see and if you're so inclined, there is the Hiawatha Trail. The Hiawatha Trail was developed several years ago on the abandoned Milwaukee Railroad grade. The main trail is reserved for bicycles or foot hiking. It's a great ride, mostly downhill, which I really like. It crosses over several very high RR Trestles and through a number of RR Tunnels. A camera is a must. At the end of the ride there is bus service to haul you and your bicycle back to the starting area. We did the ride several years ago and had a great time. Your bike must have a light and a bell and you must wear a helmet.

Our exploring will take us into the mountains and allow us to ride on many logging roads, forest service roads and abandoned railroad grades. We will stop every day and have lunch along the trail or a local cafe. We may even stop and fish or just hang out along the riverbank.

Most evenings will leave you on your own for dinner. Thursday dinner, provided by the club, will be Souper Burgers. Saturday, the club will provide meat and potatoes. Please bring a salad or desert to share. There are larger cities close by if you want to shop or explore. The drive around Lake Coeur d'Alene is a beautiful drive as is the drive into Montana and a visit to Missoula.
