SW Oregon Fall Rolling Rally~September 8-15, 2010
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Itinerary

Wed. Sept 8: The rally begins at Seven Feathers RV Resort 325 Quintioosa Blvd. Canyonville, Or. 97417, Take Exit #99 off of I-5. We will stay here one night, check in time is 2pm. Join us at 5:30 pm for a club hosted welcome barbeque at the resort's BBQ Pavilion. Bring your own beverage, otherwise water and coffee provided.

Thurs. Sept 9: We will depart Seven Feathers at check out time, 11 am for a 1 hour drive to Jacks Landing RV Resort, 247 NE Morgan Lane, Grants Pass, Or 97526. Take exit # 58 off of I-5. We hope to check in around 12:00 noon. We need to set up and be ready to leave around 2:00 pm for the 4 hour Hellgate Jet Boat Ride which includes an all you can eat country banquet dinner at the OK Corral. About a 15 min drive, this will allow some time to browse the large gift shop before our departure. We need to check in at 2:45, the boat departs at 3:15 pm. For those with pets, figure on around an 8pm return.

Fri. Sept 10: We will spend another night at Jacks Landing. Friday morning we will depart the campground around 8:15 am for a ½ hour drive to Harry and Davids Country Village at 1314 Center Drive, Medford. Check in no later than 9:00 am, our tour starts at 9:15 and last 1 hour, after which you will receive a \$5 coupon good for any purchase of \$40 or more.

Around 11 pm. we suggest carpooling to the historic gold mining town of Jacksonville, about 7 miles west of Medford. Jacksonville has some fun shops, great places for lunch and a Trolley Tour for \$5. The Trolley is available at 11 am, 12pm, 1pm, 2pm, and 3pm for \$5 for those who choose. It is fun and very informational. I was thinking we could do the Trolley tour at 12pm and then have lunch.

Friday evening is potluck at the Gazebo area. Happy hour at 5:30pm and dinner at 6:00. We will provide grilled chicken/ beef kabobs, so bring your favorite side dish, salad, or desert. I do have paper plates and plastic ware, however you can bring your own plates, utensils, and beverage. Our chapter meeting will follow.

Sat. Sept 11: We will depart Jacks Landing around 11:00 am for a 44 mile drive to The Point RV Park at Emigrant Lake, 5505 Hwy 66, Ashland, Oregon 97520. Take exit #14 and proceed east on Hwy 66, 3 1/2 miles to park turnoff. We will spend two nights here, allowing you to explore downtown Ashland, Lithia Park, and the surrounding area. There are numerous art galleries, wineries, nearby public golf courses, great restaurants and much more. Ashland is known for the Oregon Shakespeare festival, along with nine other theater groups, including musicals and comedies.
